Effective second language teaching practices will also be modeled by the facilitator, so teachers in the group can start the school year with a range of strategies and activities for use at any grade level.

Everyone at a B1+ level of French who is to take risks and accept mistakes can successfully partake in all activities. Please bring a sense of humour as these low-stress, highly interactive days offer plenty of occasions for laughter.
